RESOURCEFULNESS IS DEFINED AS HAVING THE ABILITY TO FIND QUICK AND CLEVER WAYS TO OVERCOME DIFFICULTIES.

A DISRUPTER

is a resourceful person who pushes the limits or breaks some rules. It may be necessary to deviate from a rule or process that does not create real risk or danger but allows you to move faster than usual.

Know which rules are breakable, and which are not. Breakable rules are typically the less important rules, but not ones that involve breaking the law or are unethical. Build support by running your ideas past respected coworkers or supervisors when appropriate.
